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#### FAYETTE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

THURSDAY AUGUST 4, 2022

LOCATED AT FAYETTE TOWN HALL AT 7PM

CALL TO ORDER: Called to order at 7:09pm

ROLL CALL: Jed Bartholomew, Mayor, John Bown, Bryan Lyman, Melissa Mellor, Kelly Sue Mellor was in attendance on the phone

PRAYER: Jed

1) REVIEW MINUTES: Bryan Made the Motion to accept the Minutes. John seconded the Motion. Minutes passed.

2) REVIEW EXPENDITURES: John Made the Motion to accept the Expenditures. Bryan seconded the Motion. Expenditures passed.

3) NATHAN KING WATER REPORT: Pump C is working great. But the Pump B is still having problems. The person helping will be back on Friday and Jed will let us know then. We will talk more at next Town Council. The Lightning equipment is installed and we hope it works.

4) OLDHAM, NEIL AND KAMAREE WANT TO ASK ABOUT APPROVAL OF NEW HOUSE: The Oldham's have bought property and are going to build a house. They had already talked to Dani Bown of Planning and Zoning. Jed signed off on the plans. We advised them to put the septic tank not real deep. Next move is to turn the plans into the County.

5) MEGAN JESSOP WANTS TO ASK ABOUT PAINTING HER FENCE AND HORSE PROPERTY: Sam Jessop asked if we wanted to sell the property behind them that belongs to the Town. The Council said they would rather not sell it to them because we would want to use it later. They want to paint the fence on the Park side and we said they could do that.

6) ARBNB POLICY: DO WE WANT ONE AND WHAT CHANGES NEED TO BE MADE: We will look at this at the next meeting.

7) ANNEXATION POLICY: DO WE NEED ONE? No, Not at this time.

8) FLAGPOLE BRACKETS APPROVE: Bryan looked at signs for Park and the Bathroom. It would cost around \$50. The Brackets for the flags on the poles and he could get 20 for around \$170. John Made the Motion to buy the signs and Brackets not to exceed \$250. Melissa seconded the Motion. The Motion was passed.

9) MAP FOR TOWN: HAVE WE GOTTEN ONE AND PUT IN WHAT SIX COUNTIES NEEDED? Probably not needed

10) MASON LYMAN HAS A CONCERN ABOUT THE ROAD, 2ND SOUTH: We would love Mason to get with the youth and get a project together to clean-up the sides of the streets. The town would provide the bags and then the Town would pick them up. Thank you!!
