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## FAYETTE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

**THURSDAY, JANUARY 6, 2022**

**LOCATED AT FAYETTE TOWN HALL AT 7PM**

**CALL TO ORDER: at 7PM**

**3) SWEAR IN MELISSA MELLOR AND BRYAN LYMAN FOR TOWN COUNCIL Both Candidates were sworn in. Term will be 4 years.**

**4) TOWN COUNCIL NOW HAS TO APPROVE JED BARTHOLOMEW AS MAYOR The new Council agreed to go forward with Jed being Mayor. John Made the Motion to accept Jed Bartholomew as our new Mayor. Bryan Lyman seconded the Motion to accept Jed as Mayor. Council Passed the Motion.**

**5) SWEAR IN NEW MAYOR, JED BARTHOLOMEW: After the Council accepted the Motion to accept Jed as Mayor He was sworn in as the new Mayor of Fayette. Term will be 2 Years.**

**1) REVIEW MINUTES: Brandon Made the Motion to accept the Minutes. John Seconded the Motion. Minutes Passed.**

2) REVIEW EXPENDITURES: Kelly Sue Made the Motion to accept the Expenditures, .John Seconded the Motion. Katie abstained.

7) WHITE SANITATION: White Sanitation was here to present new price on Garbage pick-up and to see about signing a new Contract with Fayette.

The new price will go up to \$10.50 a month. (That is a \$1.75 increase) The Contract is for 5 Years. Kelly Sue Made the Motion to accept the new Contract. Bryan seconded the Motion. The Motion Passed. Jed signed the new Contract.

We also set the dates for a Spring Clean-up week. April 25-May2 will be Fayette's clean-up days for 2022. They will dump it on the 28<sup>th</sup> unless needed earlier. And then return it until the 2<sup>nd</sup>.

8) SNOW PLOWING, SPRAYING FOR WEEDS, LIGHTING FOR TOWN HALL,

GARAGE DOOR, CEMETARY ROAD AND MAP:

Brandon told us that there is a Grant available to fix Cemetery for up to \$10,000.00. The time is February 1, 2022 to apply. His Company would do a GPS with a drone as an in-kind service. They would map each individual Grave.

Weed Spraying: We received 2 bids and Good's Lawn Care came in at around \$6700.00 per spray. Hal Pickett was \$1000.00 per spray. The council decided on Pickett's bid. Bryan made the Motion to accept Pickett's bid. John seconded the Motion. Motion Passed

Snow Plowing: Dave Bown is Plowing for now and is getting help from the Bartholomew's. Council is thinking of getting a blade for the Town and then whoever can use it to use around town. Price about \$10,000.00.

Lighting for Town Hall: We had a lightning strike to the building and it took out our lights on the building and they need to be replaced. Jed will change them out for us.

Garage door: Also the door to the Garage was taken out so that needs to be fixed also. Can't seem to get a hold of the man that does that. Jed will keep trying.

9) SPRING WATER ISSUES: We have 2 Engineers interested in the Water Situation. So we will check in with both and see what they say.

10) MICROWAVE IN KITCHEN: The Microwave in the Kitchen is not working. The Council said to buy a new one. (That Lightning really did a Number on our building!)

11) CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS FOR TOWN—LIGHTS ON POLE: We would like to get some lights for our town. We have around 16 Poles in town and so we need that many lights. Rocky Mountain needs to be contacted to see how much it would cost to hook up electricity to each pole. Kelly Sue and Kathi will check this out and get pricing for us. Bring to next month's meeting.

12) DANIEL ANDERSON: He wanted to know if we would let him rent out his house to others if he bought a house here in Fayette. We said he could, but he would be responsible for all of the bills, not the tenants.
